



Sarens wins Statoil Frame Agreement

Ring in the New Year, Statoil awarded Sarens AS a Frame Agreement for the provision of Crane and Lifting Operations including Transport Logistic Services for the Kårstø and Tjeldbergodden onshore facilities.

The contract period is up to six years including options. The value of the contract is dependent on activity and will vary depending on annual volume.
