

# Sarens Completes Record-Breaking Decommissioning Lift in Norway

Sarens has successfully completed a landmark decommissioning project at the Wergeland Base in Gulen, Norway, involving the lifting, transport, and re-immersion of four massive footings. The standout feature of the project was the use of Sarens' LR12500-1.0 crawler crane to lift each footing, weighing an extraordinary 1850 tonnes. Lifting such a weight with a single crawler crane is an exceptionally rare feat in Europe and may well be a record-breaking achievement.


