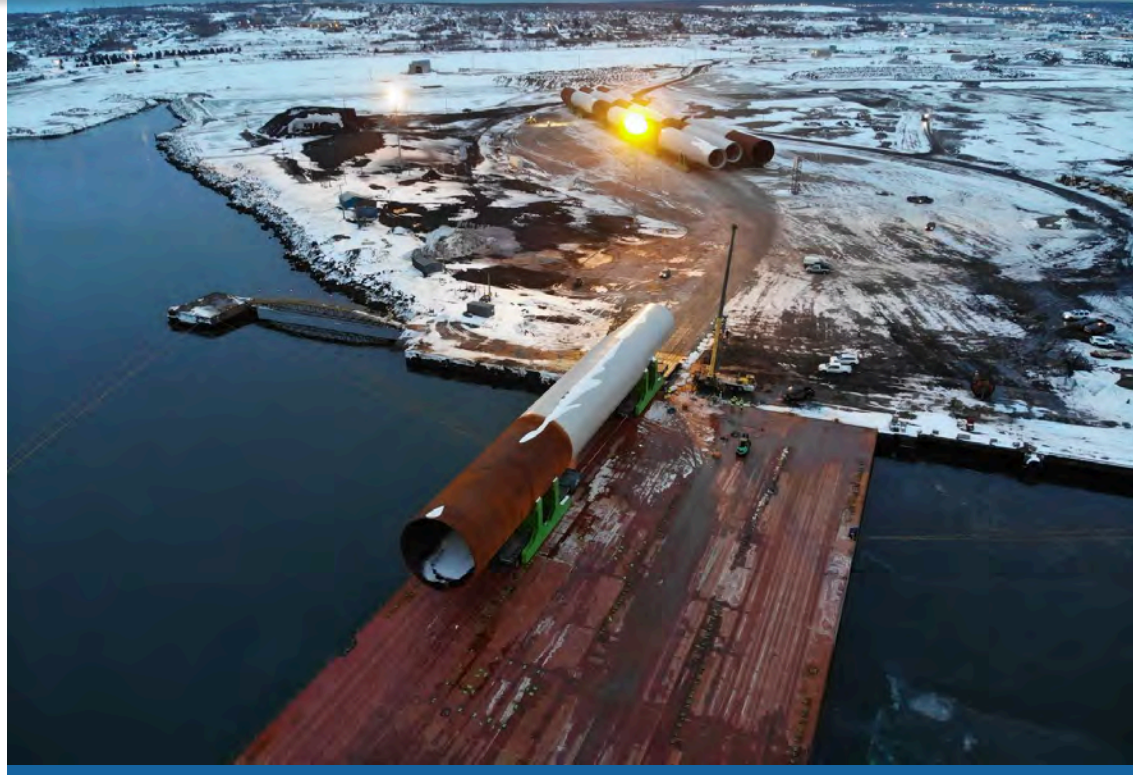

Solving Global Logistics Challenges

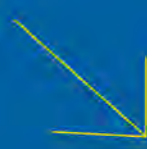
